<u>\$10,000 SAFE COP REWARD</u>

MORGANVILLE, NJ, JULY 24, 2013: Executive Director Joseph Occhipinti announced the posting of the \$10,000 Safe Cop Reward in connection with the armed assault on Cobb County (GA) Police Officer Danny Rogers on July 12, 2013 by unknown assailants in Smyrna, Georgia.

The posting of the \$10,000 Safe Cop reward was predicated upon a request from Cobb County Police Chief John R. Houser on July 23, 2013.

The Safe Cop program is a congressionally recognized law enforcement initiative of the National Police Defense Foundation that posts up to a \$10,000 reward for public information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person who shoots at a law enforcement officer, anywhere in the United States. The Safe Cop program was established in 1995 and has been instrumental in the arrest of several suspects involved in police related shooting that included the murders of Broward County (FL) Deputy Sheriff Paul Rein, St. Petersburg(FL)Police Officer David Crawford and Colleton County (SC) Deputy Sheriff Dennis Compton, among others nationwide.
